# Private Landlords 2023

# Given the current demand for social housing, the quicker solution is to look for privately rented accommodation.

# Here is the guide for finding a private let:

- 1. Ask friends and family if they know anyone who might have housing to rent.
- 2. Ask family, friends and others if they're willing to rent you a room in their home. People earning money by renting out a room in their home don't have to pay tax on the first £7,500 per year. If you find someone who's interested in renting out a room, they can call 0116 4541006 for more advice, e.g., about the tax rules or how it will affect benefit claims.
- 3. Facebook, Twitter etc. Tell your social media contacts you're looking somewhere to live. Your friends may know about property to rent.
- 4. Look in local newspapers. The 'small ads' in local newspapers often include properties for rent. Check the Leicester Mercury for free at your local library.
- 5. The internet.

# Financial assistance:

If you are signed up with the council and you find a suitable private rented accommodation please ensure you speak to the landlord in anticipation of the council being involved, and also ensure you have viewed the accommodation. The council can assist financially getting the accommodation as they pay directly to the landlord a month rent or 5 weeks deposit.

If this is the avenue you wish to utilise, please provide the following to the council:

- Landlord/Letting Agent name and phone number
- Address and post code of accommodation and bedroom range
- Rent per month and deposit amount

# If you are not signed up to the Council, please contact SHARP with assistance with the deposit.

# Guidance:

If you pay a deposit, your landlord/Lettings Agent must place this money securely with an organisation of their choosing, they must give you the reference number and the name of the company.

Plus your landlord/lettings agent must: -

- Give you a copy of the gas safety certificate if there is gas in the property
- Give you a copy of the energy efficiency form and show electrics have been checked
- Show you a certificate which shows a legionella test has been done (this checks that your water is clean and has no legionella bacteria)
- Give you a clear tenancy agreement outlining your role as a tenant and their role as a landlord/letting's agent.

Please contact SHARP if you have not been given the above in a neat pack on 0116 2546064.

Most letting agents have properties that they will accept DSS tenants for but they may ask for a guarantor.
